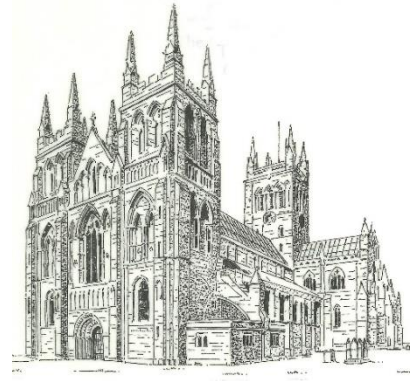


Dear all,

How to Make a Peace Be With You Sign:

1. Cut two ovals the same size out of card or paper. Draw a smaller oval within one of the pieces of card and cut it out. Stick this on the other piece of card.
2. Draw or print a small picture of a dove and glue it in the centre of the oval frame you have made.
3. Add two crosses, either drawn or printed on either side.
4. Write a Peace Be With You message and stick it on the top.
5. Add a piece of cotton, wool or ribbon to be able to hang it up.

1. Take a piece of card and coloured paper. Fold it in half.
2. Draw around your hand on one side of the paper. Make sure your thumb is touching the crease and that you leave about 10cm at the bottom of the page.
3. Cut around your drawn hand.
4. Cut out and stick a heart on each hand.
5. Write the verse "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe" John 20:29 on the strip at the bottom.
