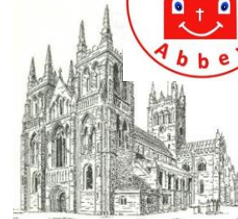

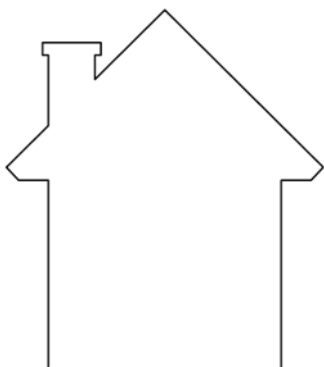

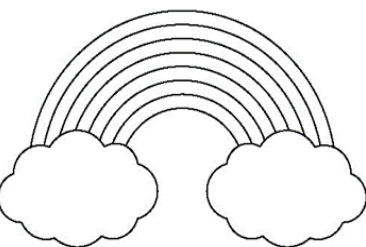


Our World

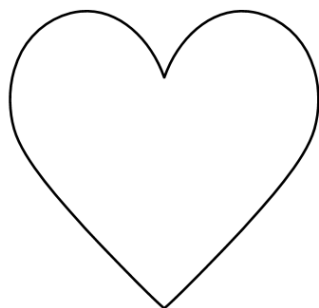
God is with us always and he listens to our prayers. He gives us love, comfort, strength, hope and peace.



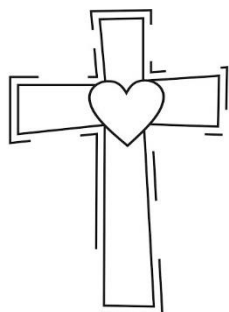

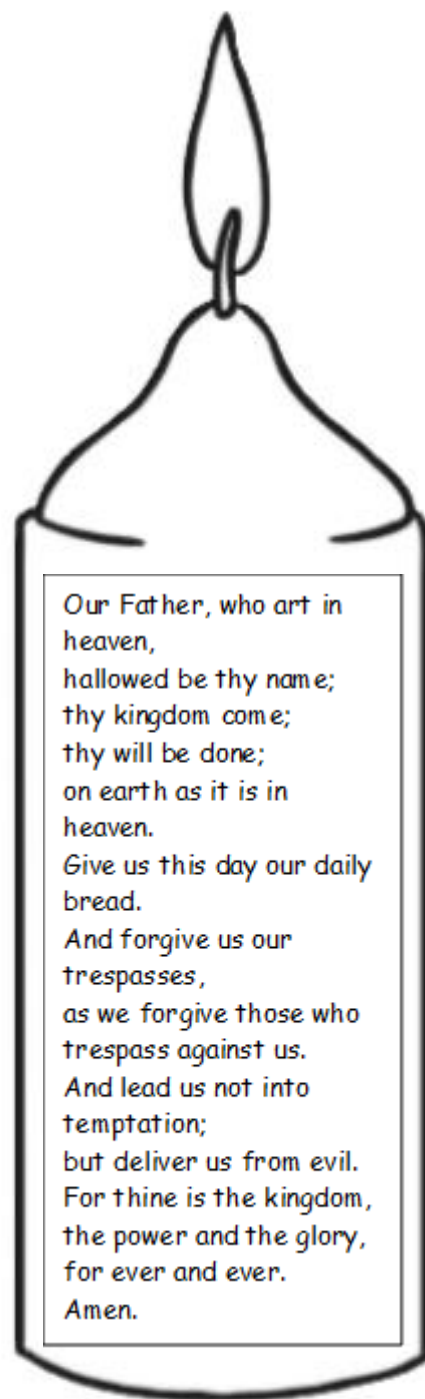
